<b>To have</b> Have, has, had	<b>+past participle</b> I have worked, she has finished ...
<b>To do</b> Do, does, did	<b>+infinitive</b> Do you love me? Does he love her ? ...
<b>Will, can, should, can't, must, have to</b>	<b>+ infinitive</b> I <b>can't</b> dance, I <b>will</b> come, you <b>must</b> listen ...
